# NROTC College Program Minimum Eligibility Requirements

The following list contains the minimum eligibility requirements for students applying for acceptance into the University of Nebraska – Lincoln's Navy ROTC program as either a Navy or Marine Corps option student. In addition to the basic requirements, students must review their service choice (Navy or Marine) specific requirements/ guidelines.

- Be motivated to serve as a commissioned officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps
- Be a United States citizen, naturalized citizen, or have submitted naturalization paperwork in which you will be naturalized prior to receiving a scholarship or contracted advanced standing opportunity
- Be enrolled at the University of Nebraska Lincoln (or applied and have been accepted to) with a minimum scheduled enrollment of 12 credit hours
- Be a high school graduate or possess an equivalent certificate
- Have no apparent physical disqualifying factor based on a review of your medical history. Utilize the <u>DD Form 2807-1</u> as a guideline in reviewing your medical history. The DD Form 2807-1 will be a completed document at a later time and is not to be submitted with this application. Common flagged disqualifications include:
  - Vision not correctable to 20/20
  - Substandard color vision
  - o History of asthma
  - o Acute or chronic cardiac/pulmonary conditions
  - Chronic skin disorders like psoriasis or eczema
  - Ununited fractures or major joint surgeries
  - Seizure disorders
  - Severe motion sickness
  - o Major shoulder injuries or surgeries
  - Alcohol or drug abuse
- Have no felony convictions or courts-martial
- Not be awaiting criminal trial or sentencing or be under any other type of military or civil restraint as a result of a violation. Traffic offenses are likely acceptable but should be noted on your application and/ or submit a supplemental form explaining the circumstances and status of the event(s)
- Have at least three years of college coursework remaining until undergraduate graduation (applies to students already at UNL and are considering applying during their sophomore year; 5<sup>th</sup> year major students may have time to complete NROTC if in their junior year)
- Be not less than 17 years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> of the year starting college and no more than 23 years old on December 31<sup>st</sup> of that same year.
- Must not have reached your 27<sup>th</sup> birthday by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which you will graduate
- Be free of drug and alcohol abuse

## Navy Option

- Meet height and weight standards for the United States Navy per Table 1 of the OPNAVINST 6110.1J
- Meet physical fitness test standards for the United States Navy per Tables 2/3 of the OPNAVINST 6110.1J
- Obtain qualifying ACT/SAT scores as listed below:
  - SAT: 530 Critical Reading, 520 Math
  - ACT: 22 English, 21 math

## **Marine Option**

- Meet height and weight standards for the United States Marine Corps per the table contained in enclosure (3), page 1 found in <u>MCO 6110.3</u>
- Meet physical fitness and combat fitness test standards for the United States Marine Corps per Tables 2-1 (page 2-5) and 3-2 (page 3-8) found in the MCO 6110.13. Note:
   \*The minimum PFT score to qualify for and maintain active status in the NROTC program is a First Class with greater than 225 total points. Students competitive for scholarships frequently earn higher than 285. Students competitive for scholarship often score a 290 or better on the CFT.
- Have no moral obligations or personal convictions that prevent conscientious bearing of arms and supporting and defending the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic or to taking an oath to perform such acts
- Obtain qualifying ACT/SAT scores as listed below:
  - o SAT: Minimum combined 1000
  - ACT: 22 Composite
  - \*Armed Forces Qualification Test Score in lieu of ACT/SAT with a minimum score of 74
- Be free of tattoos or have contacted the unit to explain the status and potential waiver opportunity of a tattoo already in place. In general, waiver granting for tattoos are not frequent
