

MECH 991 – Seminars Waiver Request

Guidelines for MECH 991

1 – All students advised by MME faculty in any M.S. or Ph.D. program and supported by a TA, RA, or Fellowship will be enrolled in MECH 991. Exceptions must be approved by the advisor and seminar coordinator.

2 – Attendance at seminars is required of all students as defined above in Item 1. Students can have up to 5 excused absences each semester. However, students should consult with their advisor and receive approval for all absences.

3 – There is no general requirement for students to provide seminar summaries. However, individual advisors may require summaries or some other work related to MECH 991.

4 – Students can substitute MME seminars with pertinent seminars from other UNL departments and centers with the approval of their advisor; the seminar coordinator should be notified.

5 – MECH 991 is a P/NP one-credit course. The students will still be able to use one credit on their programs of study.
