UNL GRADUATE COUNCIL MINUTES Meeting of April 10, 2008

The UNL Graduate Council convened at 3:36 p.m. in Room 206 of Seaton Hall. Present were: Professors Libby Jones, Nancy Miller, Nick Spencer, Pamela Starr, Mark Walker, Thomas Zorn, student representatives Benjamin Blackford and Marcus Natta; and Ex-officio: Dean Ellen Weissinger, Professor of Practice Laurie Bellows and Assistant to the Dean Barbara Brennan. Dean of Graduate Studies Ellen Weissinger presided.

March 13, 2008 meeting minutes.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

<u>Proposal for a double masters major in Agricultural Economics and Animal Science</u>. This previously tabled proposal was returned for discussion with additional information and some changes. The motion to approve a double major in Agricultural Economics and Animal Science within the Master of Science degree passed unanimously.

<u>Request for a change of degree name for the Master of Agriculture degree.</u> Discussion raised grave concerns which the members felt needed to be addressed in order to be able to complete discussion. In order to ask for more information, a motion was made to table the proposal. The motion to table passed unanimously.

The meeting then moved to Executive Session to consider a student appeal to extend the timeline on a doctoral program. The motion to uphold the student's appeal by granting one additional year was passed, seven members voting yes, one member voting no.
