## Impact At-A-Glance

The Nebraska On-Farm-Research Network completed over 70 studies across the State in 2022. Attendees at results meetings valued the program at over 10 million dollars including studies in Box Butte Co.

Several growers participated in On-Farm Research variety studies over the past several years in Box Butte County. These studies test various varieties and how they yield when direct harvested. One grower choosing the Rattler Pinto bean variety, based on our On-Farm research study results, realized a \$11,395 greater return on a 125-acre pivot compared to what the other varieties averaged. Growers appreciate seeing research carried out on their farms using their own equipment. They can see the results real time on their operation.

### Programs At-A-Glance

- Double Up Food Bucks at the Alliance Grocery Kart reached 497 SNAP EBT customers. 3,900 double up dollars were redeemed at the store for fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Robotics: 100% of youth that participated said they felt like they belonged to their team, and they talked about how science can be used to solve everyday problems.
