
The Extension Office will be closed December 24 through January 1 for Holiday Break. We will re-open on January 2. Happy Holidays!



Quilt of Valor Sewing Workday

Sewing workday for the Quilt of Valor has been scheduled for Thursday, January 2nd from 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. at the Presbyterian Church Social Hall (Southeast corner of 802 A Street) in Schuyler. 4-H members will participate in cutting, piecing and sewing a quilt top for a Quilt of Valor that will be presented to a local veteran at the 4-H Volunteer Banquet in January 2026. 4-H members with any, or no level of sewing experience are invited and highly encouraged to participate.

Quilt of Valor 2025 Award Nominations

Colfax County 4-H members have created a Quilt of Valor throughout the year. A Quilt of Valor is a quilt made using patriotic material that is presented to a Veteran member of the Armed Forces after its completion. The Quilt and its recipient are also entered into the national Quilt of Valor Foundation database to keep track of the number of quilts that have been presented around the world. The Quilts of Valor Foundation is made of a volunteer group of quilters from across the United States, including Nebraska 4-H'ers. Quilts of Valor Foundation is a national organization founded in 2003 by "Blue Star" military mom Catherine Roberts while her son was stationed in Iraq and wanted him to have a comforting piece of home with him.

The Quilt created by Colfax County 4-H members will be presented to a deserving Veteran native to Colfax County.
