## Scholarship Information Coming in November

Seward County 4-H will award scholarships to deserving 4-H'ers in the 2025 graduating class. To be eligible for these scholarships, 4-H'ers must have submitted their Achievement Application (due Oct. 5). Letters for the 4-H scholarships will be mailed out in November to eligible seniors.

### Enroll NOW for the 2024-25 4-H year!

It is time to re-enroll in 4-H for 2025. All 4-H'ers and volunteers need to re-enroll each year. The fee will be \$5.00 for each 4-H member and can be paid when you enroll online. If you have difficulties with this fee (either paying online or affordability), please visit with Extension staff.

Early enrollment date – April 1 – We strongly encourage all 4-H families to enroll as soon as possible. Re-enrolling helps ensure that you are on our mailing list (both email and mailbox). New enrollments and changes to projects will be accepted up to June 15 for fair participation.

#### Following are a few reminders:

- Project selection is now optional. By successfully completing the 4-H member enrollment by the June 15th
  deadline, youth will be eligible to participate and exhibit in any project area, contest, county, and state fairs.
  While project selection is optional, it is encouraged for youth to select projects they are interested in
  exploring.
  - Please note:
    - Youth are only eligible to exhibit in a project area or contest in a single county.
    - Horse and shooting sports projects will continue to require project enrollment due to the parental
      consent required to participate in these projects.

Please let us know if you have any questions or need help. You are welcome to set up a time to come to the office to enroll. We are here to help! Thank you!

#### Year End Treasurer's Report Due December 31

As we reach the end of the 2024 4-H year, 4-H clubs will need to prepare a Year Ending 4-H Club Treasurer's report. Even if your club does not have a treasury and does not have an EIN number, please complete the Year Ending 4-H Club Treasurer's Report and submit it to the Extension Office. Extension staff will then forward the information to the IRS for the Form 990 or Form 990 EZ. This is important so that Seward County 4-H and the Nebraska 4-H Foundation can maintain their tax exempt status.


