**Why Carpool?** In order to keep the cost of the Fall Tour as economical as possible, carpooling will be used this year. If we were to lease a motor coach, the cost per member would be \$65. By carpooling for the 50-mile roundtrip, the cost per member is \$30. This includes Museum admission, private tour with guide, gratuities, lunch, and private dining room. Riders will be asked to pay \$3-\$5 for gas.


